These three projects will be presented at a special reception the night before the NICE Annual Conference on 8th May, where the audience will vote live for the winner! In 2019, the networking reception will mark NICE's 20th anniversary too, so be sure to join us to celebrate 20 years of NICE.

As well as showcasing the finalists' work, the NICE Annual Conference will feature a poster display of 17 additional Highly Commended projects from across the UK.
